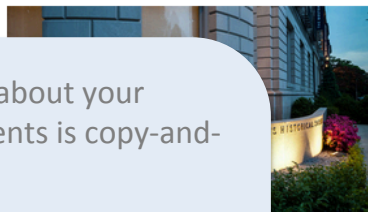
Tell It with Pride: The 54th Massachusetts Regiment and Augustus Saint-Gaudens' Shaw Memorial



Organized by the National Gallery of Art, Washington, Tell It with Pride celebrates Augustus Saint-Gaudens' magisterial Shaw Memorial (1883-1900). The monument commemorates the July 18, 1863 storming of Fort Wagner, near Charleston, South Carolina. The Civil War battle was waged by Colonel Robert Gould Shaw and
